Day 1: Fly to Sydney – the largest and most populous city in Australia and the state capital of New South Wales.

Day 3: Today proceed to Hunter Valley – a major tourist destination in New South Wales and is the 6th most visited place in Australia

After a buffet breakfast, proceed to Hunter Valley – Australia's oldest commercial wine producing district with over 7000 acres under vine. Famous wine styles include semillon, shiraz, chardonnay, gewürztraminer, cabernet sauvignon and earthy
